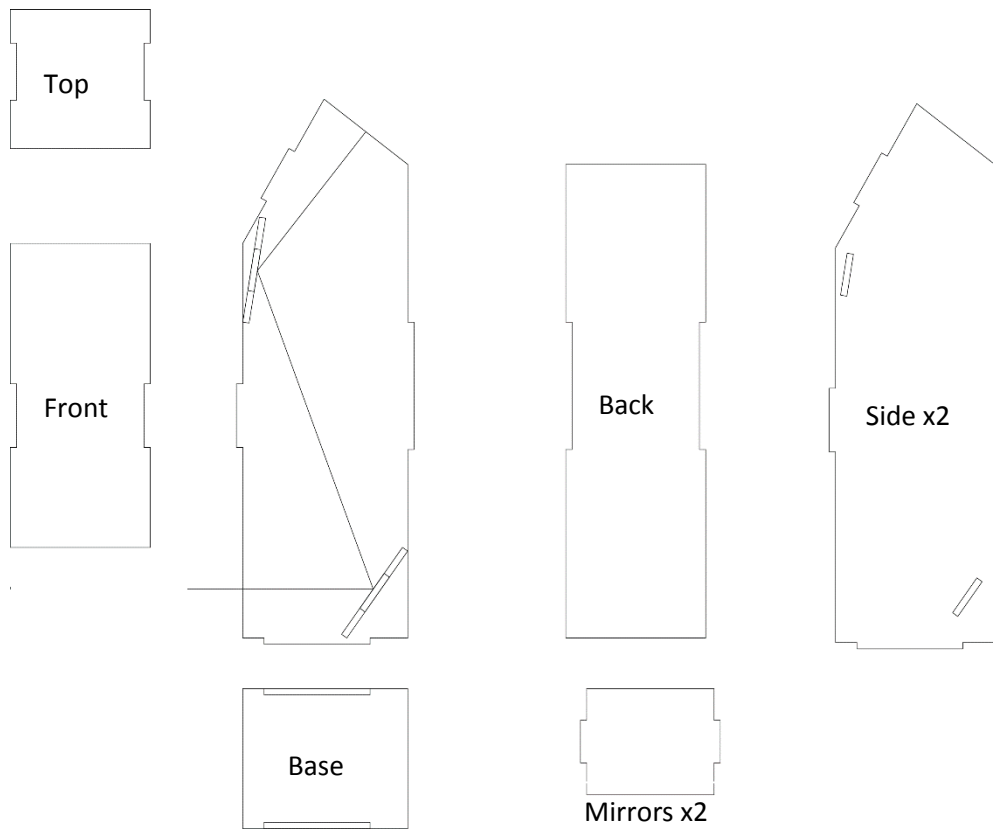


Periscope Instruction Booklet

Part list:



Step 1.

Lie one of the side sections flat on a table or workspace.

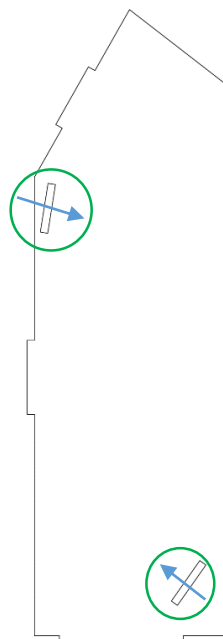


Figure 1 Mirror alignment

Check that the protective plastic cover has been removed from the front of the mirror.

Insert the mirrors into the slots highlighted in Figure 1 with the mirror facing in the direction of the arrows. You do not need to glue the mirrors in place.

Step 2.

Lay the other side section on top of the mirrors. Make sure that the mirrors sit inside the slots on both sides.

Step 3.

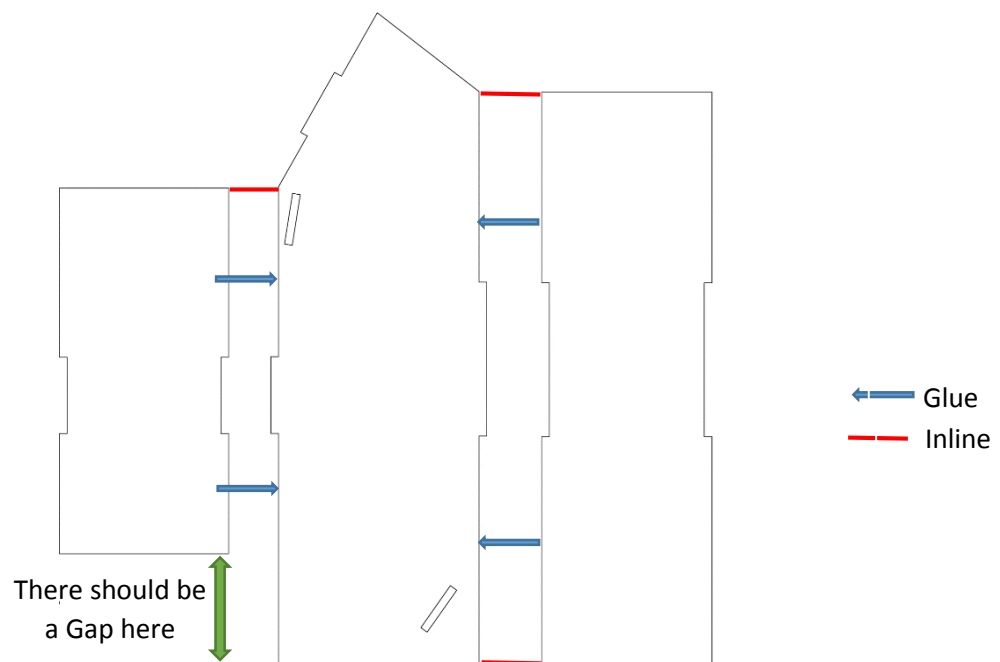


Figure 2 Assembling the front and back sections of the periscope

Glue the front and back sections to both sides at the same time. Ensure they are the correct way round as shown by Figure 2. We recommend using High Tack PVA glue. To hold the assembly tight while the glue sets we recommend placing an elastic band around the top and bottom of the periscope. Leave the glue to set before continuing to step 4.

Step 4.

Glue the top and base pieces onto the periscope as shown in fig. We recommend standing the assembly from step 3 on the base of the periscope while it is glued to make construction easier.
